TERMS OF GIFT

- By execution of the Deed of Gift the Donor represents and warrants to the Asbury Park Historical Society (APHS) that he/she is the sole owner of the title to the object(s), unless otherwise specified in writing, and has full power and authority to give the object(s) to the APHS.
- The Donor acknowledges that upon execution of the Deed of Gift the object(s) irrevocably become(s) the property of the APHS, that the Donor transfers any and all rights, including copyright, to the APHS, and that the object(s) may be displayed, stored, maintained, loaned, published, reproduced, and disposed of as the APHS sees fit and in accordance with the collections policy of the Society.
- The Donor acknowledges that because of limited exhibit space and the policy of changing exhibitions, the APHS has not promised, and is in no way obliged, to exhibit the object(s).

APPRAISAL AND TAX INFORMATION

- The APHS does not appraise donations for tax purposes as a service for visitors. For the protection of the Donor, it is recommended that appraisals be undertaken by a disinterested third party before the item is conveyed to the APHS. It is the responsibility of the Donor to make arrangements for an appraisal.
- The Donor is encouraged to seek the advice of counsel before claiming deductions for the purpose of computing income and inheritance taxes under the laws of the State of New Jersey and the United States. The Internal Revenue Service has determined that the APHS is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes and is exempt from Federal income tax. The Society's tax ID number is 22-3812489.
- Donors may be required to complete Form 8283 for Noncash Charitable Contributions on their Federal Income Tax.
